The Town of Rockport Zoning Board of Appeals is reviewing an application for use as a Tradesman's Shop made by W. Robert Walther of Camden.

The applicant proposes to construct a barn for storage and maintenance of boats on a vacant property at the corner of Grove and Union Streets (Map 30/Lot 59-12). The property is located in the Section 901 Harbor Village zoning district where use as a Tradesman's Shop is permitted only by Special Exception.

The Public Hearing will take place at 5:30 p.m., or as soon as possible thereafter, on Wednesday, July 26 in the lower floor of the Rockport Opera House at 6 Central Street Rockport, ME 04856. All are welcome to attend and provide comment for the Board's consideration. Comments will also be accepted in writing. A meeting on site, known as a Site Walk, has also been scheduled for 5:00 p.m. the same day (just prior to the Public Hearing). To attend the Site Walk, please park in the former doctor's office lot at 195 Union Street and walk over. Site Walks are open to the public, however no public comment will be taken on site.
