

City of Rockland Patrol Officer

Applications are being accepted to fill an anticipated position and to establish an eligibility list for a Patrol Officer with the Rockland Police Department. Applicant must be a high school graduate and possess a valid driver's license with a good driving record. Applicant must have satisfactorily passed the ALERT Test. Candidates will be required to successfully pass an in-depth background check; oral, psychological, and physical agility tests; and medical and polygraph examinations.

Salary: \$827.86 to \$1055.68 per week based on qualifications to start. Maine State Retirement at 2/3 pay after 25 years.

Benefits: 11 paid holidays plus one floating holiday. Vacation: 1 year = 2 weeks; 5 years = 3 weeks; and 10 years = 4 weeks. Sick leave accrues at 1 day per month. Health insurance is with Northern New England Benefit Trust. 20% of the monthly cost for the group is paid by employees. There is Maine State Retirement, of which 8% is paid by the employee and the City contributes 8.3%. This is a collective bargaining position. Possible overtime.
