

Town of Thomaston PROPOSED SEWER RATE INCREASE

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Users of the Thomaston public sewer and residents of Thomaston are encouraged to attend a Public Hearing to be held Monday, February 11, 2019 at 7:00 PM in the Selectboard meeting room at Watts Hall.

The purpose of this hearing is to allow public input regarding a proposed increase in sewer user rates. This increase, if approved, would raise the residential rate from the current \$5.00 per 100 cubic feet of water used to \$5.50, the commercial rate from the current \$5.30 per 100 cubic feet of water used to \$5.83 and the industrial rate from the current \$4.25 per 100 cubic feet of water used to \$4.67 and annually thereafter, beginning on July 1, 2021, for the next four years all rates would increase 2.0% on July 1st of each year.

Also included is an increase in the minimum billing rate to \$49.50 per quarter for residential users and \$23.32 per month for commercial users. The new sewer connection fee (SSDC) will be increased from the current \$7.50 per gallon to \$8.60 per gallon with a flat rate of \$1,000 for a single-family residential dwelling.

This is the first-rate increase since 2013.
